School Crossing Update

Exciting news to see the completion of additional safety flashing lights and our crossing supervisor present on the school crossing both before and after school. Marita Stecko visited our school yesterday and completed the Crossing Supervisor training for Nik Clegg. We look forward to having Nik take on this vital role in our school community.

We have spoken to the children about safety after school especially those children crossing Boundary Road. We received reports about children unaccompanied by adults not crossing the road properly. Children have been reminded that the only place to cross Boundary Road is at the flagged crossing. We ask that parents support us and model the correct behaviours with their children.

Thank you to the majority of parents/grandparents who follow the correct procedures in the carpark and in the drop off/pick up kiss and go zone. This does allow everyone to leave our school safely.

This semester we will again be holding a parent information session to explain the reporting process within our Diocese and how this reflects what is required by the Australian Curriculum. It would be great to see you there on Tuesday 19th June and Thursday 21st June from 4.30 to 5.00 pm. The session will be approximately half an hour in length.

It is vital that if you wish to view your child's report card at the end of the semester, you must have logged onto the school Parent Portal and set up a password. If for any reason you are unsure how to do this, please see Aimee in the office who will be able to help you with this process.







