St Joseph's Weipa Homework Policy

Purpose

At St Joseph's Parish School, we believe that homework is most effective when it:

- Is clearly related to class work.
- Is appropriate to particular years of schooling.
- Is varied and differentiated to individual learning needs.
- Consolidates, revises and/or applies students' classroom learning.

Application

Practise and consolidation of skills learnt at school to include:

- Math consolidation and practise.
- Reading will be a daily homework activity, with the inclusion of completing a reading log each week.

In addition to the above, there may be occasions when assigned tasks are set to be completed at home.

Procedure

Recommended Time Allocations

- P - 2 - 10min – 20min per session three to four times per week.
- 3 - 4 - 30mins per session three to four times per week.
- 5 - 6 - 30min - 45min per session three to four times per week.

Laptops and School Devices

- As per the SJW Student Laptop Agreement, laptops are issued exclusively for educational purposes only (no online chats, games).
- Laptops can be sent home to use whilst completing homework if it is deemed necessary by the classroom teacher for students in Years 5 – 6 only.
- If laptops do go home, it is the responsibility of the students to ensure they come to school each day, fully charged.
